MAIN CHARACTERS: ANGELA, INFECTION PREVENTIONIST GEORGE, ER PHYSICIAN

SCENE 1		
TIME:	MORNING	
PLACE:	HOSPITAL WARD	
SONGS:	(1) YOU WASH GOIN' IN/OUT 🛛 🎜	
	(2) I AM A VIRTUAL WASHING MACHINE	

3 NURSES DANCE AS THEY ENTER AND EXIT 3 ADJACENT PATIENT ROOMS. THEY ANSWER PATIENT CALLS, WASH HANDS ON ENTRY AND EXIT. THEY DISPLAY WASHED HANDS TO THE PATIENTS. THEY TAKE VITAL SIGNS, HAND OUT MEDICINES, AND ENTER DATA INTO THEIR RESPECTIVE FREE-STANDING COMPUTERS. ANGELA ENCOURAGES THE NURSES, CLEANS THE COMPUTER KEYBOARDS, TAKES CULTURE SAMPLE OF THE FLOOR, FILLS A GEL DISPENSER THAT HAS JUST RUN DRY. ANGELA STREAKS BACK AND FORTH (ON ROLLER SHOES) AS SHE DOES THESE TASKS ENTHUSIASTICALLY.

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NURSES SING: YOU WASH GOIN' IN, YOU WASH GOIN' OUT

- Nurse #1: YOU WASH GOIN' IN, YOU WASH GOIN' OUT YOU WASH IF YOU TOUCH THINGS LYIN' ABOUT TWO HANDS IN THE AIR SHOWS THE PATIENT WE CARE THAT'S WHAT IT'S ALL ABOUT
- Nurse #2: YOU WASH GOIN' IN, YOU WASH GOIN' OUT YOU WASH THOUGH WE ARE INTO A FULL-BLOWN DROUGHT TWO HANDS IN THE AIR SHOWS THE PATIENT WE CARE THAT'S WHAT IT'S ALL ABOUT
- Nurse #3: YOU WASH GOIN' IN, YOU WASH GOIN' OUT YOU WASH WHEN YOU TOUCH A PATIENT WITH GOUT TWO HANDS IN THE AIR SHOWS THE PATIENT WE CARE THAT'S WHAT IT'S ALL ABOUT

NURSES SING: I AM A VIRTUAL WASHING MACHINE

- NURSE #1 SINGS: WENT TO THE HOSPITAL THE OTHER DAY TO SEE MY PATIENTS AND COLLECT MY PAY WASHED MY HAND AT LEAST A THOUSAND TIMES NO ONE GOT INFECTED SO I DON'T MIND
- CHORUS GROUP: I WAS SOAPING AND GELLING, RUBBING AND SCRUBBING IF YOU KNOW WHAT I MEAN GIVING A WHOLE NEW MEANING TO HAND CLEANING I'M A VIRTUAL WASHING MACHINE
- **NURSE #2 SINGS:** TOOK THOSE VITALS AND PASSED THOSE MEDS HELPED A THOUSAND PATIENTS IN AND OUT OF BEDS

- CHORUS GROUP: I WAS SOAPING AND GELLING, RUBBING AND SCRUBBING IF YOU KNOW WHAT I MEAN GIVING A WHOLE NEW MEANING TO HAND CLEANING I'M A VIRTUAL WASHING MACHINE
- NURSE #3 SINGS: I CHARTED AND REPORTED TO COMPLY WITH THE FEDS I HELPED A THOUSAND PATIENTS TO AND FROM THE HEADS ALL THE TIME I WAS CONSTANTLY WASHING TAKING EVERY WASHING PRECAUTION
- CHORUS GROUP: I WAS SOAPING AND GELLING, RUBBING AND SCRUBBING IF YOU KNOW WHAT I MEAN GIVING A WHOLE NEW MEANING TO HAND CLEANING I'M A VIRTUAL WASHING MACHINE

- Nurse #1: Look at my hands
- Nurse #2: Mine are raw
- Nurse #3: Mine too
- **Angela:** It's tough on hands washing and gelling every time but it protects our patients.

BEFORE STARTING HIS NIGHT SHIFT DR. GEORGE IS SITTING AT A CAFETERIA TABLE PLAYING A POP SONG ON HIS LAPTOP PIANO APP. WHEN ANGELA ENTERS, HE SWITCHES TO "GONNA MOVE MY FEET TO THE SUNNY SIDE OF THE STREET". ANGELA TAP DANCES TO THE NEXT TABLE AND TAKES A SEAT. BOTH LAUGH.

- ANGELA: Live music in the hospital cafeteria. That's great, I can practice my dance moves.
- GEORGE: I take requests. I haven't seen you here before. Where do you work?
- **ANGELA:** All over the hospital. I'm Angela.
- GEORGE: I'm George. Nice to meet you. What do you do?

ANGELA DOES A MARCHING DANCE WHILE SINGING.

ANGELA SINGS: I AM AN INFECTION PREVENTIONIST

ANGELA SINGS: I AM AN INFECTION PREVENTIONIST I LEAD THE BATTLE AGAINST DEADLY BUGS THERE IS NO RETREAT, NO SURRENDER IT'S EITHER THEM OR US

WE TEACH, PREACH AND BESEECH FOR EFFECTIVE HAND HYGIENE

- GEORGE:
ANGELA:You sure are passionate about your work! You must be super busy during Covid 19.ANGELA:Yeah, no days off for 3 weeks. It's been crazy. Helping with vaccine inoculation of staff, training everyone
in proper PPE use. Setting up special Covid floors with unique air flow requirements. Hand hygiene
compliance is high now during Covid. I hope it stays up. What do you do George?
- **GEORGE:** I'm an ER doc. I work the night shift till 7 o'clock.
- **ANGELA:** What kind of patients did you see last night?

GEORGE SINGS: I'M AN ER DOC

GEORGE SINGS: I SAW A LADY WHO BROKE HER HIP WHEN SHE TRIPPED A SKATEBOARDER WHO BROKE HIS ARM WHEN HE FLIPPED A BEE FARMER WHO GOT BADLY STUNG A CYCLIST HIT A TREE AND COLLAPSED HIS LUNG

> I SEE STROKES AND HEART ATTACKS COUNTLESS FOLKS WITH PAINFUL BACKS I SEE ENDLESS VARIETY EVERY SEGMENT OF SOCIETY

- **ANGELA:** You must really like it to work nights.
- **GEORGE:** I love it! I sleep in the mornings and afternoons do whatever I please.
- **ANGELA:** What do you like to do on your time off?
- **GEORGE:** I play piano and compose songs. I'm restoring a 1931 Ford Roadster. This is how it's gonna look. (Shows picture of beautiful, restored car on iPhone and appears on big screen above stage)
- ANGELA: My dad worked on the family car. I admire a guy who can work on cars.
- **GEORGE:** And I'm training for the Boston Marathon, but I can't seem to get past 8 miles.
- ANGELA: What stops you?

GEORGE: My back tightens up. What do you do when you are not preventing Infections?

- **ANGELA:** I love all kinds of dance. Especially Irish and ballet. I also do yoga. By the way, yoga is good for back problems. And there are some amazing new treatments that help back spasm.
- **GEORGE:** Maybe you can show me the treatment. Why are you here so late? I take it you work days.
- **ANGELA:** Yes. I teach the student nurses at 7 AM tomorrow but my demonstration patient flaked so I have to make a different lesson plan.
- **GEORGE:** What does the demonstration patient do?
- **ANGELA:** Nothing. He sits in bed while I examine him and teach about hand hygiene.
- **GEORGE:** Maybe I can help. I'm very good at lying in bed and doing nothing.
- **ANGELA:** I couldn't ask you to stay past the end of your shift. You must be exhausted after 12 hours working in the ER.
- **GEORGE:** No problem. Where is your lecture? If I do a good job maybe we can trade services. You can give me a yoga treatment for my back.
- ANGELA: Okay. The lecture is in the Education Bldg. ROOM 3 at 7 AM
- **GEORGE:** See you there.

ANGELA AND GEORGE LEAVE IN DIFFERENT DIRECTIONS. GEORGE IS SMITTEN. LEAVES SMILING.

ACT III		
SCENE 1		
TIME:	MORNING	
PLACE:	EDUCATION BLDG	
SONG:	(5) WATER AND SOAP 🏾 🎜	

STUDENT NURSES, 2 MALE AND 2 FEMALE STAND AROUND. GEORGE SITTING SHIRTLESS IN BED

ANGELA: OK if I examine you/ GEORGE: Sure

ANGELA TAPS HIS CHEST, PUTS STETHOSCOPE TO HER EARS, LISTENS TO HIS CHEST.

ANGELA: What do you think? Did I do a proper exam on George?

STUDENT 1: You didn't listen to both sides of his chest.

STUDENT 2: You didn't listen to his heart.

ANGELA DIPS HER HANDS INTO GREEN FOOD DYE AND SMACKS GEORGE'S CHEST FRONT AND BACK. THE DYE DRIPS ALL OVER HIS CHEST AND LEAVES BLOTCHES. GEORGE IS SHOCKED AND GRIMACES.

GEORGE WHAT THE HECK!

ANGELA: The green represents the bacteria that I transferred to Dr. George when I didn't wash before examining him. They reside on my hands and stethoscope. We each have thousands of bacteria on our hands.

ANGELA SHOWS 2 PETRI DISHES GROWING DARK GREEN BACTERIA COLONIES. (SHOWS ON BIG SCREEN)

- ANGELA: See these bacterial colonies? I plated them from my unwashed hands 2 days ago. When I examined George without first cleaning my hands, I transferred these bacteria to him, just like the green dye. We <u>MUST</u> wash before and after touching the patient or items in the room, before procedures, and upon exiting the room. Just remember that touching a patient without first thoroughly washing is like slapping green dye on them.
- NURSE 2: When do we wash with soap and water? When is gel best?
- **ANGELA:** Good question. Soap and water is better if hands are visibly dirty, after use of the restroom, before eating and if you are dealing with diarrheal disease like C Diff or diarrhea from a norovirus. For most other situations cleaning your hands with gel is fine.
- NURSE 3: What is the best way to clean our hands?

ANGELA SINGS: WATER AND SOAP

WATER AND SOAP RUB YOUR HANDS TOGETHER CIRCULATE THAT FOAMY LATHER RIGHT ON LEFT STEADY AND STRAIGHT LEFT ON RIGHT ALTERNATE LET THOSE FINGERS INTER-DI-GI-TATE

KNUCKLES TO PALMS AT A RAPID RATE GRAB THOSE THUMBS LEFT AND RIGHT ROTATE FINGERTIPS TO PALMS AND AGITATE SWITCH HANDS AND REITERATE

RINSE WITH WATER, TOWEL DRY TO A HYGIENIC STATE

ANGELA WIPES THE GREEN DYE OFF GEORGE.

ANGELA HANDS OUT WASH INSTRUCTION SHEET. STUDENT NURSES THANK ANGELA AND GEORGE, APPLY GEL AND LEAVE

- **GEORGE:** How did I do? Was I a good demonstration patient?
- **ANGELA:** You were great! If you have recovered from the paint slapping and have time let's go to the hospital gym. I'll show you a yoga exercise so you can run without back pain
- GEORGE: Okay

SCENE 2 PLACE: HOSPITAL GYM

GEORGE AND ANGELA SITTING IN THE HOSPITAL GYM ON YOGA MATS

George: Why did you become an infection preventionist?

Angela: It's an interesting story. When I was a kid my dad almost died from an infection in the hospital and I remember an Infection Preventionist figured out what was wrong and saved his life. I was so amazed I knew right then that's what I wanted to be and here I am. Let's fix your back. Where does your back hurt when you run?

George: Right here.

HE POINTS TO HIS LOW RIGHT BACK. SHE POSITIONS HIM ON THE MAT AND DEMONSTRATES THE DOWNWARD DOG AND STANDING FORWARD FOLD.

Angela: You're going to do each pose to the count of five. Now you try the yoga poses and I'll count out loud to 5.

GEORGE PERFORMS THE EXERCISES WHILE ANGELA COUNTS OUT LOUD AND DIRECTS HIS MOVEMENTS. AS HE COMES UP FROM A STANDING FORWARD FOLD. ANGELA SMACKS HIM HARD ON HIS RIGHT LOW BACK (LOUD SLAPPING SOUND)

George: Oww! That hurt. What was that for?

Angela: It's called smack therapy. It should help prevent your back pain. Do these yoga exercises daily. Let me know if you can run further.

ANGELA AND GEORGE LEAVE, GEORGE WALKS STIFFLY HOLDING HIS HAND TO HIS BACK.

SCENE 3 TIME: EVENING PLACE: HOSPITAL CAFETERIA

GEORGE SEATED DRINKING COFFEE. ANGELA ENTERS AND SITS

- **ANGELA:** How's your back doing?
- **GEORGE:** I can't believe it. I ran 11 miles today with no back pain! It's a miracle!
- **ANGELA:** Glad it helped but don't forget to do those yoga stretches before and after you run. Every day!
- **GEORGE:** OK but I hope you don't need to slug me again.
- **ANGELA:** Not for a while. And how is your car restoration going?
- **GEORGE:** I just got a hood and I'm going to install it next. And by the way I've started writing a song for you. **ANGELA:** Oh, let's hear it.

George plays 4 bars of "I'd Be A Loose Canon"

- **George:** That's all I have so far.
- **Angela:** I can't wait to hear the rest.

ANGELA AND GEORGE LEAVE IN DIFFERENT DIRECTIONS. WAVING TO EACH OTHER.

HOUSEKEEPERS-3 WOMEN, 2 MEN. ALL IN UNIFORMS. SEATED. LONG BROOMS, CLEANING EQUIPMENT AND GIANT UV LIGHTROOM STERILIZATION MACHINE DISPLAYED PROMINENTLY. GEORGE IS SEATED IN BACK OF THE HOUSEKEEPERS. ANGELA POINTS TO ALL THE ITEMS SHE TALKS ABOUT. HOUSEKEEPERS DANCE WITH EQUIPMENT WHILE ANGELA SINGS.

- ANGELA: Housekeepers play a critical role in sterilizing the contaminated environment. When the patient has C.diff bacteria form spores that spread throughout the room and out the door. Those spores can survive 6 months or more and require powerful chemicals plus UV light to kill. Your terminal cleaning methods include removing all detachable objects and sanitizing them. You clean lighting and air duct surfaces and walls and everything down to the floor. You do an amazing job.
- **HOUSEKEEPER:** When I clean the hospital I think of the patients as my family and how I want to keep my family safe.
- ANGELA SINGS: HOUSEKEEPERS ARE GREAT
- ANGELA SINGS: YOU KNOW WHO MAKES OUR HOSPITAL GREAT KEEPS US IN AN ORDERLY STATE

IT'S HARD-WORKING HOUSEKEEPERS THAT'S WHO LISTEN TO WHAT THEY DO

THEY DECONTAMINATE EACH ROOM AND FLOOR THEY CONSTANTLY CLEAN THE CORRIDOR CHANGE LINENS. MAKE BEDS UP RIGHT SO PATIENTS CAN SLEEP THROUGH THE NIGHT

THEY TERMINALLY CLEAN METICULOUSLY INCORPORATE ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY INCLUDING STATE OF THE ART U.V. TO KEEP ROOMS BACTERIA FREE

THEY RESTOCK TOWELS, SOAP, AND GEL SO WHEN WE WASH WE DO IT WELL IF THEY WEREN'T HERE I CONFESS WE'D BE IN A TERRIBLE MESS

SO WHEN YOU SEE THEM WORKING NIGHT AND DAY TO KEEP DEADLY BACTERIA AWAY THANK THEM FOR MAKING OUR HOSPITAL GREAT AND KEEPING US IN AN ORDERLY STATE

HOUSEKEEPERS THANK ANGELA AND EXIT. ANGELA SEES GEORGE AND WALKS OVER TO HIM.

- **ANGELA:** George, I didn't expect to see you here.
- **GEORGE:** I didn't realize how important floor sanitation is. We need one of those UV light machines in the ER.
- **ANGELA:** I'll talk to our housekeeping director and see if we can get one for you. Have a great day! And remember to do those yoga exercises!

SCENE 2TIME:EVENINGPlace:HOSPITAL CAFETERIA

GEORGE DRINKING COFFEE. ANGELA ENTERS AND SITS AND STARTS WORKING ON HER LAPTOP

- **ANGELA:** Hi! How was your day?
- **GEORGE:** Great! I ran 13 miles. Back held out.
- **ANGELA:** Wonderful. How is your car restoring?
- **GEORGE:** I just installed the carburetor. When I get it done I'll take you for a ride. Why are you here so late?
- ANGELA: There is a very sick patient in the ICU with pneumonia complicated by Acinetobacter baumannii. It's a bacteria that's resistant to every known antibiotic. Such resistance is becoming frequent now. I belong to APIC, acronym for Association for Professionals in Infection Control and Epidemiology, It's my support group for IP's. I heard a lecture at the June convention by an Infection Prevention Professor in San Diego whose patient became progressively ill, and comatose with resistant Acinetobacter baumannii. She located Scientists in Texas and at Walter Reed Hospital and obtained a virus called a phage and administered to him I.V. It saved his life. I'm sending her an email inquiring if phage therapy can help our patient.
- **GEORGE:** I hope you get a quick response. I'm starting my shift in a few minutes. Want to hear what I have so far of your song? (PLAYS 6 BARS)
- **ANGELA:** I feel special. A song just for me.
- **GEORGE:** You are special, Angela. I have to start my shift in the ER. I hope you get a response to your email soon.

ANGELA CONTINUES WORKING AT HER LAPTOP. GEORGE LEAVES. GLANCING BACK AT ANGELA AND HE CATCHES HER SMILING AT HIM

SCENE 3		
TIME:	MORNING	
PLACE:	LECTURE ROOM 3	
SONG:	(7) BAD BUGS TAKE OVER	Γ.

ANGELA ADDRESSING 3 FEMALE NURSES AND 2 MALE NURSES IN SCRUBS. GEORGE IS IN BACK OF ROOM. DURING SONG ANGELA POINTS TO COMPUTER AND CLEANS KEYS. HOLDS UP CELL PHONE, PLACES IN UV STERILIZER. SWIPES GEORGES PHONE AND STETHOSCOPE WITH CLEANING WIPE.

- ANGELA: Cell phones, computer keyboards, stethoscopes, scrubs get colonized with bacteria and viruses we can't see. We need to disinfect these items. UV light is very effective but if not available use disinfectant swipes repeatedly.
- ANGELA SINGS: BAD BUGS TAKE OVER
- ANGELA SINGS: BACTERIA AND VIRUSES HANG OUT ON COMPUTER KEYS THEY HITCH A RIDE AS YOU TYPE YOUR HISTORIES. IF YOU DON'T CLEAN THEM OFF, THEY'LL DO AS THEY PLEASE GIVE YOUR PATIENTS THE RUNS AND A TON OF MISERIES
- ANGELA: RESISTIVE STAPH COLONIZE YOUR CELLPHONE DAY AND NITE OUT SMART THEM AND ZAP THEM WITH UV LIGHT

OR YOU CAN SMACK THEM OFF WITH A CLEANING WIPE THEN KEEP ON SWIPING THEM OUT OF SIGHT

10/28/2022 NURSES SING CHORUS:

JS: BAD BUGS TAKE OVER SO WHAT YOU NEED TO DO IS CLEAN YOUR GEAR CONSISTENTLY

DON'T LET THEM TAKE OVER YOU

ANGELA: KLEBSIELLA AND PSEUDOMONAS LIKE YOUR CUFFS AND TIE DITCH THEM. BECOME AN OPEN COLLAR GUY CHANGE THOSE SCRUBS. PUT ON A NEW ONE EVERY DAY THAT'S HOW TO KEEP THOSE KILLER BUGS AWAY

ANGELA: VIRUSES THINK YOUR STETHOSCOPE IS A COOL PLACE TO NEST THEY JUMP TO YOUR PATIENT WHEN YOU LISTEN TO THEIR CHEST IF YOU CLEAN YOUR STETHOSCOPE, AND DO IT CONSTANTLY YOU WILL AVOID THIS INFECTIOUS CALAMITY

NURSES SING CHORUS: BAD BUGS TAKE OVER SO WHAT YOU NEED TO DO IS CLEAN YOUR GEAR CONSISTENTLY DON'T LET THEM TAKE OVER YOU

SURGICAL NURSES THANK ANGELA, GEL AS THEY LEAVE. GEORGE LEAVES WAVING AT ANGELA AND SHOWING HER THAT HE IS CLEANING HIS CELL PHONE

SCENE 4 TIME: EVENING PLACE: HOSPITAL CAFETERIA

ANGELA SEATED. DRINKING COFFEE. GEORGE HOBBLES IN WITH RIGHT FOOT IN WALKING BOOT

- **ANGELA:** What happened to you?
- **GEORGE:** I ran 15 miles and was doing great and then my foot hurt. An MRI shows a hairline stress fracture. I need to rest my foot for 6 weeks and use this walking boot. I messed myself up.
- **ANGELA:** Oh gosh. And you were so looking forward to running the Boston Marathon. I should have warned you to increase those miles gradually.
- **GEORGE:** It's not your fault.
- **ANGELA:** What will you do? I know that running is a big part of your life. When I used to run it kept me in shape and on an even keel. I was relaxed all day.
- **GEORGE:** Yeah. It definitely helped me stay mellow.
- ANGELA: You can try some yoga exercises that are good for relaxing. Here is a website

ANGELA SHOWS GEORGE A WEBSITE OF YOGA EXERCISES

GEORGE: Thanks. I'll check it out.

BOTH LEAVE CAFETERIA SEPARATELY

ACT V SCENE 1 TIME: MORNING PLACE: LECTURE ROOM 3

ANGELA ADDRESSING 2 PHYSICIANS, WEARING WHITE LAB COATS AND 3 PHARMACISTS WEARING BLUE. GEORGE IN BACK OF ROOM.

ANGELA: What is Antibiotic Stewardship? A steward is a person who oversees and takes responsibility for something. As antibiotic stewards we take responsibility for the appropriate use of antibiotics.

ANGELA: You volunteers are vital to making our patients comfortable.

- **VOLUNTEER SING: VOLUNTEERS ARE GREAT VOLUNTEER #1 SING:** WE REASSURE YOUR FAMILY **GIVE DIRECTIONS TOO** SO THEY ARE CALM AND COLLECTED WHEN THEY TO COME VISIT YOU **VOLUNTEER #2 SING:** WHEN YOUR SPIRITS ARE DOWN WE BRING THEM UP ITS HARD TO FROWN WHEN YOU'RE KISSED BY THE HOSPITAL PUP CHORUS: WE ARE ALWAYS READY TO HELP AND WE ARE ALWAYS NEAR WE ARE LOOKING OUT FOR YOU
- VOLUNTEER #3 SING: IT'S TOUGH TO KEEP HANDS CLEAN WHEN YOU CAN'T WALK TO THE HEAD WE'LL BRING SOAP AND WATER SO YOU CAN WASH UP IN BED
- VOLUNTEER #4 SING: WE ARE GONNA KEEP YOU COMFORTABLE DURING YOUR HOSPITAL STAY AND WE ARE GONNA CHECK UP ON YOU EVERY SINGLE DAY

EVENING HOSPITAL CAFETERIA

GEORGE SEATED DRINKING COFFEE HE IS NOW IN A NECK COLLAR (BRACE). FOOT STILL IN WALKING BOOT. ANGELA ENTERS AND SITS AT NEXT TABLE.

- **ANGELA:** What happened? Why the neck collar?
- **GEORGE:** I went to your website and found a yoga relaxing exercise called Sirsasana where you stand on your head with your body against the wall. It was SO relaxing but then I felt a snap in my neck, and I couldn't turn my head. Doctor John the Orthopedist says I have a pinched nerve at C6.
- **ANGELA:** Oh no! How long do you need that collar?
- GEORGE: I go back to Ortho next week. I'll be OK. It's not your fault
- ANGELA: Don't stand on your head or do any more yoga exercises on your own. Please run them by me first. Just work on your car. That should be safe. Tomorrow I'm teaching the importance of hand washing to the kids on the pediatric floor. I dress in a cat outfit. I hate to impose on you, but you can help if you are available. The kids are so enthusiastic, and they love the Sesame Street dress up we do. I am Mimi the cat. And You can be Baxter the hospital dog. It's on the Pediatric Floor at 7:30 AM. There's a piano on the Peds floor. Could you play the hand washing song for them to wash and dance to while I demonstrate good washing?
- GEORGE: Sure. And I'll jazz it up!

SCENE 4 TIME: MORNING PLACE: PEDIATRIC WARD SONG: (10) WATER AND SOAP

2 GIRLS, 2 BOYS AGES 9-10 SITTING TALKING TO EACH OTHER ANGELA SEATED REVIEWING NOTES. GEORGE ENTERS, TO ANGELA, SPOTS PIANO, SITS AND STARTS PLAYING BALLET MUSIC FROM SWAN LAKE. ANGELA JUMPS UP AND STARTS DANCING BALLET.

GEORGE: Angela, you're a great dancer!

ANGELA: Thanks George! Play some Wash Your Hands Music for the kids!

ANGELA

(DRESSED

AS MIMI

THE CAT): That's good! Kids we need to wash our hands with soap and water when our hands are dirty, before we eat, after we use the restroom.

ANGELA DEMONSTRATES THE PROPER 8 HAND WASH MOVEMENTS AS GEORGE SINGS AND PLAYS ON THE PIANO EXPRESSIVELY. AS SHE SHOWS EACH KID HOW TO WASH PROPERLY AND THEY DO IT ANIMATEDLY.

GEORGE SINGS AND PLAYS ON PIANO:

WATER AND SOAP

WATER AND SOAP RUB YOUR HANDS TOGETHER CIRCULATE THAT FOAMY LATHER RIGHT ON LEFT, STEADY AND STRAIGHT SWITCH THOSE HANDS, ALTERNATE LET THOSE FINGERS INTERDIGITATE

KNUCKLES TO PALMS AT A RAPID RATE GRAB THUMBS LEFT THEN RIGHT ROTATE

FINGERTIPS TO PALMS AGITATE SWITCH HANDS AND REITERATE RINSE WITH WATER, TOWEL DRY TO A HYGIENIC STATE

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Boy 1: I don't like cats. They don't really wash their hands.

BOY 2: Yeah, dogs are better.

GIRL 1: Cats are cleaner than dogs. Dogs slobber all over you.

- **GIRL 2** Yeah, cats are better. Cats even lick their paws.
- **BOY 1**: You girls don't know anything. Cats eat mice. They are filthy dirty.

ANGELA: Baxter, I think that's your cue

GEORGE PUTS ON COSTUME OF BAXTER THE HOSPITAL DOG. SINGS AND DANCES WITH THE KIDS AND THEN GEORGE SITS AT PIANO AND PLAYS AN IRISH JIG. ANGELA, DRESSED AS MIMI THE CAT DANCES AN IRISH JIG WITH THE KIDS TRYING TO KEEP UP AS GEORGE PLAYS FASTER AND FASTER. ANGELA AND ALL

THE KIDS FALL TO THE GROUND LAUGHING.

KIDS LEAVE AND GEORGE AND ANGELA ARE ALONE SITTING ON THE PIANO BENCH

ANGELA: George you were great! Thanks for your help. Tomorrow, I teach hand hygiene to the older kids. If you'll be in the cafeteria tonight, I'll tell you about it.

GEORGE: Yeah, I will be. And by the way do you want to hear what I've added to your song? **ANGELA:** I'd love to.

George plays 10 bars.

- **ANGELA:** Wow! I can't wait to hear the rest of it. It has lyrics, right?
- **GEORGE:** I'm working on the lyrics. I hope you like them.

SCENE 5 TIME: EVENING PLACE: Hospital Cafeteria

GEORGE SEATED DRINKING COFFEE. HIS RIGHT SHOULDER NOW IN A SLING FOOT STILL IN WALKING BOOT, NECK IN COLLAR BRACE. ANGELA ENTERS AND IS AGHAST

- **ANGELA:** NOW what happened George? I just saw you this morning.
- **GEORGE:** You won't believe this. I attached the hood and propped it up. I was working on the engine and the hood started falling. I reached up to stop it and wrenched my shoulder. I think it's just a strain. I'll be OK. I'm going to leave the hood off.
- **ANGELA:** I was going to ask you to be Baxter the hospital dog again tomorrow when I teach hand hygiene to the older kids but I hesitate to ask. You look like a walking catastrophe.
- **GEORGE:** I look worse than I feel. I'll be there at 7:30 AM
- **ANGELA:** No I can't ask you.... it's too much.
- **GEORGE:** I'll see you tomorrow.
- **ANGELA:** OK George, But only if you're sure.

SCENE 6 TIME: MORNING

PLACE: PEDIATRIC WARD SONG: (11) WASH RAP 10/28/2022 <u>GEORGE IS NOT PRESENT</u>. MIMI DANCES AND DEMONSTRATES PROPER HAND HYGIENE. KIDS AND ANGELA SING, AND HIP HOP TO THE WASH RAP

ANGELA:Did you practice the wash rap I taught you last month?KIDS:YEAH! Do you want to see our moves?

KIDS SING: WASH RAP

IF YOU WASH RIGHT EVERY DAY YOU WILL KEEP C-DIFF AWAY IF YOU GEL RIGHT EVERY DAY YOU WILL AVOID MRSA
